Audition Requirements for Chromatic Connection (Adult) Membership

- Candidates must submit this this application (including all repertoire and the accompanist's name) to the appropriate Audition Chairperson *at least* one week prior to the audition date. *Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.*
- 2. Any selection that includes piano accompaniment requires that an accompanist be used. Applicants are responsible for engaging their own accompanists for the auditions. If any applicant does not have his/her own accompanist, he/see may contact the Audition Chairperson for a list of current Club members who accompany. Note: Fees for accompanying are to be arranged between the applicant and the accompanist.
- 3. Candidates will be notified of the judges' decision by mail. All decisions are final.
- 4. All selections must be written by different composers and must be in the original keys.
- 5. No pre-recorded auditions or accompaniments will be allowed (for any reason).
- 6. All selections are subject to approval by the Audition Committee in advance.
- 7. No audition is necessary if the applicant is a former member of the Student Group whose dues are current and whose performance expectations have been met.

Voice (Memorization Preferred)

A. Classical

- 1. One Classical Italian art song
- 2. One art song or aria in English
- 3. One art song or aria in any language other than English

B. Musical Theater

- 1. One turn-of-the-century song or operetta selection (e.g., Romberg, Lehar, Gilbert and Sullivan, etc.)
- 2. One song from a pre-1960 musical (e.g., Rodgers and Hammerstein, Cole Porter, etc.)
- 3. One song from a 1960 or post-1960 musical

C. Crossover

Option 1

- 1. All Classical requirements (see A.)
- 2. Plus one song from a musical

Option 2

- 1. All Musical Theater requirements (see B.)
- 2. Plus one art song or aria in a language other than English

Piano (Memorization Preferred)

- 1. One of Bach's Two or Three-Part Inventions or a Baroque piece of comparable difficulty
- 2. Two additional pieces/movements from contrasting periods

Orchestral Instruments (Memorization Optional)

- 1. One movement from a sonata or concerto
- 2. Two additional pieces/movements from contrasting periods

Percussion Instruments (Memorization Optional)

Three contrasting selections using at least two of the following instruments:

1. Snare drum (e.g., Advanced Etudes from Cirone, Wilcoxen, etc.)

- 2. Marimba (e.g., Solo or Etude from Gardner, Goldberg, etc.)
- 3. Timpani (e.g., Firth's Solo Timpanist any one, Jones' Sonata, Carter's Solo, etc.)

Instrumental Ensembles (Memorization Optional)

Three contrasting pieces representative of the literature available for the instruments - avoid transcriptions, if possible.
